Contemporary Forgery – circa 1913/1914

History/Background - An early World War I anti-conscription related organization, calling itself "Industrial Workers of the World" (IWW), was creating a lot of political angst with its strong stand on conscription and other social issues.

It is alleged that some of its members were involved in a private syndicate producing and releasing forged £5 Commonwealth banknotes throughout the country.

At the time, it was alleged that the IWW organization was involved in a gigantic plot to disrupt Australia's finances and dampen the war effort by distributing over 25,000 pounds worth of forged five pound notes.

Following the discovery of the forgeries, a mosaic of fives was added to the reverse of the £5 note in 1914. The horizontal red/yellow bands on the first design were also replaced by a vertical phasing of the purple/yellow/purple colours.

An important and historic contemporary note forgery.

Decimal "Dated" Annual Issues,

In 1994, Note Printing Australia (NPA) began "dating" its banknotes by including the year of manufacture as part of the serial number. Following the two letter prefix, the first two digits of the serial number indicates the year followed by the normal six figure serial number. For example, a note with the serial number AA 94 000100 would mean that the note was issued in 1994. These special issues enabled enthusiasts to put together date sets in much the same way that collectors have saved yearly mint and proof coin sets. Some of these notes were not issued in these years due to the durability of the polymer note. All date sets hereunder have the rarer Red Serial Numbers. Only 900 of each year notes were issued, making these notes very scarce.
